

## **Invitation to tender for delivering a workshop of Clay 3D Printing at EKA/ESTONIA**

Invitation to Tender

The Estonian Academy of Arts (EKA) organises the 3rd Summer Academy for international and local students this year, and invites offers for the delivering of a workshop on topic of Clay 3D Printing in EKA.

The aim of the course is to use innovative thinking to discover new ways of printing, using clay and printed ceramics. The end of the workshop will feature a pop-up exhibition of the objects created. Every participant needs to bring their own laptop. All other materials are provided, and students may keep the objects they print.

### **The course details:**

- group: 13 students (ceramics, architecture and design students, but admission is open to all students who have had experience with 3D printing and know how to create 3D files)
- amount: 56 academic hours (academic hour = 45 min)
- duration: 7 days in August 2019 (1 extra day is for students to prepare their work)
- Language: English

**Trainers have relevant training experience preferably in academic/international context. Desirable is Master Degree in the field.**

### **LEARNING OUTCOMES. The student is able to:**

- KNOWS about the design foundations for ceramic 3D printing;
- KNOWS how to conceptualise ideas through 3D modelling software and prepare print files;
- KNOWS how to prepare clay material and operate 3D printing equipment;
- HAS EXPERIENCE in working individually and in small groups;
- IS ABLE to present design concepts.

Cost – a maximum day rate up to 401 Euros per day. Please note that travel and accommodation expenses will be paid by EKA (economy class travel).

### **Selection Criteria:**

- Track record - Experience of delivering training in Clay 3D Printing in academic/international context where the audience have been students of ceramics, architecture and design (50%)
- Cost (30%)
- Qualification (20%)
