

Invitation to tender for delivering a workshop of Designing and Facilitating Learning at EKA

The Estonian Academy of Arts (EKA) organises good practice seminars and courses for its faculty, and invites offers for the delivering of a workshop on topic of Designing and Facilitating Learning. We are looking for tenders for the following course aimed at our faculty:

The aim of the course:

The aim of the course is to understand experiential and action learning in order to design and facilitate innovative and creative education and learning in the field of arts, design and architecture.

The course details:

- group: 18-24 participants (faculty and study support personnel in the field of arts, design and architecture)

- amount: 24 academic hours (academic hour = 45 min) / 1 ECTS

- duration: 3 days in January 2020

- Language: English

Trainer (or trainers) has relevant training experience preferably in academic/international context and holds a Degree in the field of arts or design. The trainers should have at least 5 years of working background in Project Management in design field and at least 2 years of teaching experience in the field.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

- Experience in action, experiential learning and facilitation.
- Able to design education for creative practice that promotes problem solving, curiosity, lateral thinking, leadership and taking action.
- Explore the potential in the roles of the learner, the educator, the learning experience and how
 to encourage the students to take initiative, responsibility for their own learning, and to self
 evaluate
- Knowledge of informal and formal learning processes such as project work, scenarios, role plays, talk-shops, open space, peer to peer, dialogue, feedback and listening tools, offering alternative ways of working with Assessment, learning, feedback and planning.

Please note that food, travel and accommodation expenses will be paid by EKA (economy class travel).

Available budget:

The proposal should be cost-effective and based on market rates with a budget of no more than €11000 in total. EKA will cover the expenses for travel and accommodation separately though Erasmus program

Selection Criteria:

- Track record Experience of delivering training in Designing and Facilitating Learning in academic/international context where the audience have been students of design, art and architecture (50%)
- Cost (30%)
- Qualification (20%)
