Estonian Academy of Arts, Faculty of Design, invites proposals from individual consultants and consulting agencies to facilitate a design sprint for a cross-border healthcare service design project Co-Designing Healthcare (NPHZ-2018-10108)

With a view to improving interactions among research and healthcare infrastructure providers, the Bidder should help the Faculty of Design and its collaborators – HE as well as healthcare institutions – to plan and execute a 3-day design sprint in healthcare. The Bidder is to run a *Sprinting the Sprinters* workshop, enabling its participants – designers, design leads as well as healthcare decision-makers and practitioners – to reflect on and develop further co-design as a collaborative research method.

All interested in bidding should submit a brief proposal for performing the assignment, including providing information on their qualifications and experience.

Closing date:

December 20, 2019

Award of the contract:

Mid-January 2020, including the facilitation of a 3-day design sprint 16 – 18 March 2020 in Tallinn, Estonia

Duration of the assignment:

The assignment should be completed within 2 months of awarding the contract.

Deliverables:

New tools and/or frameworks to update design sprint methodology, especially in relation to participatory, co-creation, and open design processes.

Budget:

The proposal should be cost-effective and based on market rates with a budget of no more than €2000 in total.

The Bidder must factor in all possible costs, including consultation fees, honorarium, and any additional costs.

All travel and accommodation costs within the Nordic-Baltic region will be covered.

Qualifications and Experience:

Postgraduate Degree at Masters level from a recognized university in the field of service or systems design, and proven experience in co-design methods (i.e. workshops and prototyping techniques), including patient and public engagement and involvement.
